Must hold a Master's Degree in related field and a current LPC, LMFT or LCSW (Partially Licensed and Interns may be considered). Bilingual a plus!

Summary

This position will be responsible for providing; Crisis Intervention, Individual and Group Therapy, Case Management, Group Facilitation for victims and assist in carrying out Psycho educational Youth Prevention Programs when required.

Duties

- Provides Crisis Intervention services to Child and Adult Victims of Sexual Assault.
- Provides Crisis Intervention services to Child and Adult Victims of Domestic Violence.
- Works with Director of Programs as directed under the Sexual Assault Primary Prevention Program.
- Works under the supervision of the LPC Supervisor to provide counseling services to Child and Adult Victims of Sexual Assault.
- Works under the supervision of the LPC Supervisor to provide counseling services to Child and Adult Victims and other Violent Crimes.
- Provides Family Violence Prevention & Crisis Intervention resources to Child Victims and their parents/caretakers.
- Assist in the development of program curriculum when required.
- Assists in carrying out the curriculum through our education programs when required.
- Assist the Director of Programs in preparing Victim Services monthly statistical information for grant funders as required.
- Works with the Victim Services Program to ensure program cohesion and training to staff and volunteers when required.
- Assist in providing training to School District Staff and Community Stakeholders in accordance with grant funding requirements.
- Other duties as required.
